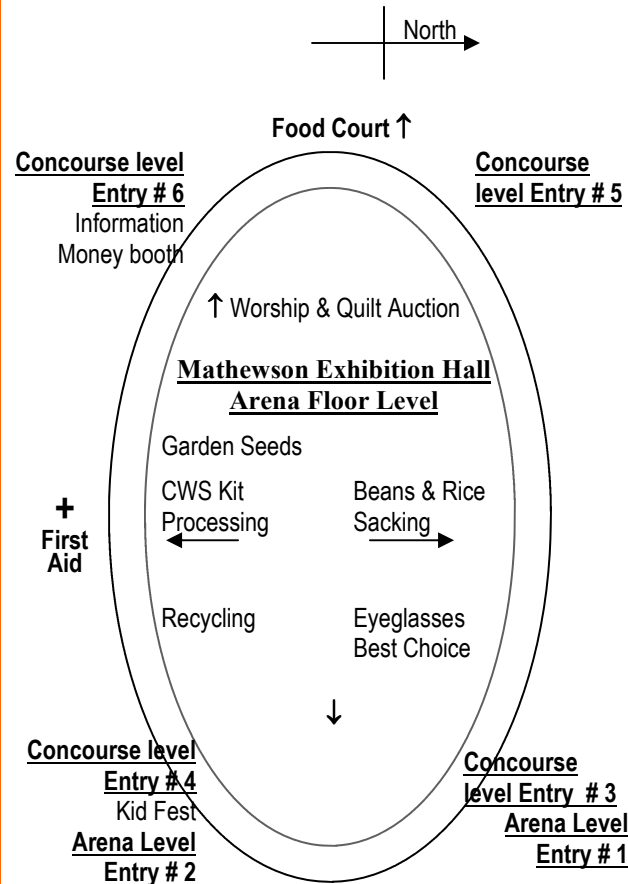

**Habitat for Humanity** - The Habitat program in MO. (Kansas City) will be highlighted in this workshop and information about Habitat's work in Uganda that has made a difference in the lives of many.

**Bread for the World** - This year, letters of advocacy are focused on making a difference for hungry people through urging Congress to reform foreign aide.
