EMERGENCY CLEAN-UP BUCKET

These kits enable people to begin the overwhelming job of cleaning up after a disaster here in the United States.

Shipping—\$3/kit

Please purchase all liquids in plastic bottles. Send only new, unopened materials. Make sure lids on bottles are tightly closed. Put all items in the plastic bucket, making sure they are packed securely to avoid damage during shipment. Seal closed with lid.

HEALTH KIT

In the face of natural disasters, violence, or poverty, these kits can mean the difference between sickness and health for family members.

Shipping—\$2/kit

Seal all items in a one-gallon plastic bag with zipper closure, remove excess air from bag, and seal leaving only a ½ " open. Toothpaste with extended expiration dates will be added to the Hygiene Kits Shipments just prior to shipment.

SCHOOL KIT

These kits give children in impoverished schools and refugee camps some basic tools for learning.

| 1- 30-centimeter ruler (12") | 6 new pencils with erasers |
| 1 pencil sharpener (hand-held) | 1 large eraser |

Layettes provide gentle warmth for infants and basic tools for young mothers struggling with poverty or the consequences of natural disaster.

6 cloth diapers
2 t-shirts or undershirts (no onesies)
2 gowns or sleepers
2 receiving blankets (1 can be a knitted blanket)

Shipping—\$2/kit

2 diaper pins
2 washcloths
1 sweater or sweatshirt

All items should be new. Bundle items inside one receiving blanket and secure with diaper pins.

These kits are for women living in developing countries. More than 50 million women give birth at home annually without the help of a trained professional or sterile birthing supplies. Increasing the mortality rate of the infant and the mother.

Other items and Shipping \$15 / kit

1 Jacket or tunic

Place the three items in a zip lock bag. Items can be handmade or purchased. The other items for the kit will be added by IMA World Health. To complete the kit IMA needs \$15 for providing sterile birthing supplies and for shipping. The Safe Motherhood Kit developed by IMA World Health is designed to improve the chance for a safe delivery . The Kits are being channeled through the health system and made available at health clinics.

IMA Medicine Box

Each IMA Medicine Box contains enough medication and supplies to treat the common ailments of several thousand people. IMA accepts donations of specific over-the-counter items to include in Medicine Boxes. Please follow these guidelines for donations, which should be new products with unbroken seals and expiration dates of 18 months (April 2012) or longer . Generic products are welcome!

500 tablets or more **Acetaminophen** (Tylenol), 325 mg or 500 mg,

500 tablets or more **Ibuprofen** (Advil, Motrin), 200 mg,

500 tablets or more **Multivitamins with iron** (One-A-Day), w/out herbs or special formulas

500 tablets or more **Children's Multivitamins with Iron** (Flintstones Chewables w/ Iron),

6 tubes or more **Triple antibiotic ointment** (Neosporin), ½ oz. or 1 oz. tube,

50 pads or more **4x4 inch gauze pads**, any brand,

2 rolls or more **½ inch adhesive tape**, any brand

Place items inside a **1-gallon zip lock bag**. Pack filled zip locks in boxes labeled "**Student Dental Packs**" and mark the **quantity** on the outside of **each box**. The extra brushes are for family members.

Place items in a sturdy box or book carton, tape and label "Family Food Pack."

Personal Hygiene Pack - Pack Value \$ 20.00

Tighten lids and place all items in a **large zip lock bag (2-gallon size works best)**. Place zip locks in boxes labeled **“Personal Hygiene Pack.”** Please also mark the **quantity** on the outside of **each box**.

Women’s Prison Pack - Pack Value \$ 9.00

- 1 Emery Board (not a metal nail file)
- 1 Pencil (unsharpened, no advertising)
- 30 sheets of writing paper, 6”x9”, (no note cards)
- 5 Envelopes (white standard size, not business size)
- 1 Shampoo (12-16 oz. size, alcohol-free only) *Acceptable brands: Suave, Equate Herbal, Personal Care Herbal, Alberto VO5, Style
- 1 Tube toothpaste (6 - 6.4 oz. size, alcohol-free only) *Acceptable brands: All types of Ultrabrite, Colgate, Crest, Aquafresh & Gleem
- 1 Deodorant (2-3 oz. size, alcohol-free only, no roll-ons, no men’s brands) *Acceptable brands: Revlon Hi & Dri, Lady Mitchum Clean Gel, Crystal Clean Deodorant, Almay Clear Gel, Simple Basic Clear Deodorant

Place only these items in a plastic bag. Put filled bags in boxes labeled **“Prison Pack.”**

Backpacks of Love - Pack Value \$40.00

- 1 small backpack or small duffle (**NO backpacks with wheels**)
- 1 small stuffed animal
- 1 t-shirt (Child Medium, Child Large or Adult Small)
- 1 pair socks
- 1 pkg. - 3 pair underpants
- 1 narrow tooth comb
- 1 youth toothbrush (soft and in unopened, original package)
- 1 travel pillow
- 1 tube child flavored toothpaste, 4 - 6 oz.
- 1 coloring book (for age 4-7) or 1 notebook (for age 8-11)
- 1 box crayons (for age 4-7) or 1 pencil (for age 8-11)

A small quilt or blanket already donated will be added to the kit. **Please pack all items in the backpack and label the box “Backpacks”**. These kits are used by children between the ages of 4 to 11 who have experienced a crisis and are being placed in foster care.

Put all the items in a drawstring bag approximately 15" X 22". Please use solid color fabric to allow the teen to personalize the bag. All items should be placed inside the bag with the draw string pulled. Place kits in a box and label "Youth Pack" and the number of packs in the box. These kits are used by children between the ages of 12 to 18 who have experienced a crisis and are being placed in state care.
